3 Simple Steps to Get Started

Step 1



Be Prepared

- a... Dress to impress. You only get one chance to make a first impression.
- b... Have a bowling resume to give to the coaches (free template at www.RecruitUS.net)
- c... Have a list of questions to ask coaches (you can find some sample questions from Recruiting #5 that was emailed to all registered bowler's parents)

Step 2



Talk to ALL Colleges

- a... Even if you are not interested in a particular college, talk to them anyway. –By talking to all college coaches, you will begin to see how programs are similar and different. –And it will give you a better chance at finding the best college for you.
- b... The college coaching community is a small world. Coaches will help you get connected with the right coach or will be able to give you suggestions that will help you find the right fit for your goals.

Step 3



Follow-up, Follow-up, Follow-up

- a... After the event let college coaches know if you ARE or ARE NOT interested in their program. There is no wrong decision here. What CAN you hurt you, is you stringing a college coach along. If you let them know up front, they will most likely be willing to help you get connected with the right school for you.
